HON. CARLOS R. MORENO



Associate Justice Carlos R. Moreno received a B.A. in Political Science, then attended Stanford Law School. He first worked as a deputy city attorney in Los Angeles, then joined a commercial litigation firm. In 1986, Governor Deukmajian

appointed him to the Municipal Court and he was assigned to Compton. In 1993, Governor Wilson elevated him to the L.A. Superior Court. President Clinton nominated him to the Federal bench in 1998. He was unanimously confirmed. In 2001, Governor Davis nominated him to the California Supreme Court. He has been the President of the Mexican American Bar Association. He is the Director of the Arroyo Vista Family Health Center and he is the Chair of the California Blue Ribbon Commission on Children in Foster Care.

HOLLY FUJIE



Last July, Holly Fujie was elected president of the State Bar of California. The state bar is an administrative arm of the California Supreme Court, and its membership of more than 217,000 includes all practicing lawyers in the state. Prior to being elected president, Fujie

had served two years as a governor of the state bar representing Los Angeles County and one year as vice president. Becoming only the third woman chosen as president since the organization was established in 1927, Fujie took office in September and made it clear that one of her major talking points during the next year would be the issue of diversity in the legal profession.
